Did you know...

Identity theft is the fastest growing crime in America, topping the Federal Trade Commission's list of consumer complaints for seven consecutive years.

Consider the following national Statistics:

- Losses from Identity Theft totaled \$56.6 billion in 2005. It was 3.5 times greater than the total of all losses for burglary, larceny and motor vehicle theft combined.
- The Federal Trade Commission estimated that out-of-pocket expenses for victims of Identity Theft and Fraud increased nearly 50% in 2006.
- It takes victims an average of 175 hours to clean up their lives after an Identity Theft.
- There are 27,000 New victims of Identity Theft daily.

Steps to reduce your risk:

- Do not carry your Social Security card in your wallet or purse.
- Shred anything with your name, address, or other sensitive data before discarding it.
- Use a secure locking mail box or a post office box.
- Use online bill pay. This removes confidential info from the mail.
- Never write your Social Security number on your checks.
